

What's Going On in K.I.V.O.?

Passover, the first of the major Jewish festivals, begins at sundown on Monday, March 29th and ends Tuesday, April 6th.

Preparing for Passover will take many days of cleaning and inspecting before we can declare K.I.V.O. to be "Kosher for Passover."

From Dinner on March 21st until the end of Passover, all food and food items in K.I.V.O. must be strictly Kosher for Passover. Food that contains any leavened products such as bread, cake, cookies or pasta are prohibited in K.I.V.O. throughout the festival.



All dishes, serving plates, and cooking utensils are reserved for Passover only as well.

No food, dishes, utensils, cups or condiments from outside of K.I.V.O. will be permitted in the K.I.V.O. dining area from March 21 – April 6.

Passover Schedule

In order to make these necessary preparations, K.I.V.O. will be following this special schedule:

Sunday, March 21st

- Both Meat & Dairy Sides of K.I.V.O. Will be Open for Dinner, Serving a Modified Passover Menu
- **No food, dishes, utensils, cups or condiments from outside of K.I.V.O. will be permitted in the K.I.V.O. dining area from now until the end of Passover.**

Monday, March 22nd – Sunday, March 28th

- Both Meat & Dairy Sides of K.I.V.O. Will be Open, Serving a Modified Passover Menu

Monday, March 29th – Wednesday, March 31st

- K.I.V.O. is Closed
- Kosher for Passover Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner will be available in the Catering Suite for students who sign up in advance.
- ***You must sign up by Friday, March 26th before 10:00 a.m. by e-mailing Kevin.Dean@fandm.edu, in order to guarantee that Kosher for Passover food will be available for you.***

Thursday, April 1st – Saturday, April 3rd

- Both Meat & Dairy Sides of K.I.V.O. Will be Open, Serving the Passover Menu

Sunday, April 4th – Tuesday, April 6th

- K.I.V.O. is Closed
- Kosher for Passover Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner will be available in the Catering Suite for students who sign up in advance.
- ***You must sign up by Friday, April 2nd before 10:00 a.m. by e-mailing Kevin.Dean@fandm.edu, in order to guarantee that Kosher for Passover food will be available for you.***
